She currently serves on the Ways & Means, or "budget" Committee, where she chairs the K-12 and Capitol Improvements budget subcommittees. She is Chairman of the Health & Human Services Committee and serves on the Elections and Procedures Committee. Debbie served as Chairman of the Council to Establish Academic Standards for eight years leading the state through the initial process of developing and passing the state's first academic standards.

Debbie is a past President of the Nevada Parent Teacher Association, as well as a former board member of the National PTA. She is an Education Alliance board member, an advisory board member of the Angel Kiss Foundation and a former Lander County School Board member.
