Jon Bunker was named chief executive officer of the southwest region of UnitedHealthcare upon close of the merger between UnitedHealth Group and Sierra Health Services, Inc. Since August, 2006 he was the president and chief operating officer of Sierra. From 2000 to 2006, Jon was president of Sierra's Managed Healthcare Division.

Bunker was president of Sierra's Western Region from January 1997 to 2000, and was vice president of HMO and Insurance Operations since 1996. At that time he also was appointed president of Health Plan of Nevada, Inc.; Sierra Health and Life Insurance Company, Inc.; and Sierra Healthcare Options, Inc. In 1997 Bunker was named president of SHS subsidiary companies Med One Health Plan; Prime Health, Inc.; Prime Holdings, Inc.; M.E.G.A., Inc.; and Elias Ghanem, Ltd.

Prior to joining Sierra, Bunker was vice president of John Alden Horizon Health, a Nevada corporation. From 1989 to 1990 he served as vice president of Prime Health. From 1985 to 1989, Bunker held several positions with Sierra Health and Life Insurance Company, Inc., a Sierra PPO subsidiary, including vice president of operations, chief financial officer, and director of finance. A native Nevadan, Bunker earned a bachelor's degree in accounting from Utah State University, Logan, Utah, in 1982. He is married with five children.
